Festival Volunteer Information & Conditions

Welcome to our 24th Annual Summer Solstice & World Peace Celebration. We thank you for your interest in volunteering with us at SNWMF 2017. We have been very fortunate with the quality and loyalty of our dedicated volunteers. We depend on your reliability and commitment to doing a great service for this festival and our attendees. Please read the following information and conditions for volunteering at this year's SNWMF.

VOLUNTEERING FOR SNWMF - All volunteers must agree to the following terms & conditions, sign both sides of this document and if applicable, submit the required deposit before they are accepted. **If accepted, you will be contacted and confirmed in advance.** No on-site sign-ups. **Volunteers will be scheduled to do shifts totaling 15 - 16 hours (3 – five + hour shifts).** Positions and hours are assigned in advance and will be posted on the day of check-in. Please read and sign this form and fill out the entire Interest Form (opposite), with signature and date. Be sure to list your email address, phone number and mailing address. **This completed document, and deposit (\$100.00 if required) are due by: June 1st, 2017, unless otherwise approved.**

SITE CHECK-IN – THURSDAY JUNE 15th, 10AM – 5PM ONLY! – All volunteers must arrive and check in on **Thursday, between 10AM and 5PM only!** No early arrivals will be permitted entrance so please do not arrive before Thursday the 15th. Check-In location will be at the Veterans Hall, adjacent to the fairgrounds. “Volunteer Check-In” signage will be posted. Please do not bring family or friends that are not already scheduled. Anyone that is not scheduled (family, friends, etc.) must be a ticket holder and may not be on the property before Friday morning opening at 9am. Please make advance child care arrangements for your children (under 12). Children are not allowed to be in your care during your shifts.

ON SITE CONDITIONS – **Limited on site camping is available. All volunteers will be required to unload camp gear and park their vehicles off site (high school only, please!) so do not plan to sleep in your vehicle.** Instructions will be given upon arrival. SNWMF does not allow any alcohol or drug use during your volunteer shift. SNWMF prohibits any illegal activity or taking bribes (money, merchandise, alcohol or drugs, etc.) from patrons or any others, while on or near the property. SNWMF also prohibits the unauthorized selling of anything to anyone, (merchandise, tickets, passes, camping, alcohol, drugs, etc.) for personal gain or any other reason. SNWMF **does not allow dogs**, fireworks, firearms, vending, amplified music, off road vehicles, bicycles, scooters, skateboards, etc., on the property at any time. **Alcohol is not permitted to be brought in to the bowl.** Please keep alcohol in your camp areas, or purchase inside from one of our beer booths. As this is a public venue, we expect your conduct and actions to be appropriate throughout the weekend. Everyone should be off the property and out of vehicle park areas by Monday at 12 PM.

NEEDED SUPPLIES – **All volunteers must bring/provide their own food and drinks during the festival.** Volunteers scheduled to work 8 hour shifts will be provided one meal during that shift. You may be scheduled for shifts during the day or night hours therefore, we suggest you bring the following; a water bottle with plenty of extra drinking water, food/snacks, a chair, sunscreen, a hat, and comfortable shoes (no sandals, etc.), a flashlight with extra batteries and very warm clothes. We also recommend bringing a mist or spray bottle and backpack or bag to keep things cool and collected. You will not be permitted to leave your post to get additional supplies so please come prepared for your entire shift.

I understand that this is only an interest form and that if accepted, I will be contacted by SNWMF. I understand that SNWMF Coordinators will assign my hours and duties to me as they see appropriate to the festivals needs. I understand that I will be required to do 16 hours of volunteer time. SNWMF will provide me with, one 3-day general admission ticket, one 3-day camping pass, and a volunteer t-shirt in order for me to fulfill my obligation. I understand that the use of alcohol, illegal drugs or participation in any illegal activity, before or during my volunteer shift will not be tolerated by SNWMF. SNWMF also prohibits dogs, and the unauthorized selling of anything to anyone, (merchandise, tickets, passes, camping, alcohol, drugs, etc.) for personal gain or any other reason. **I agree to arrive and check-in on Thursday, June 15, 2017, 10:00am - 5:00 pm, and attend an 8:00pm mandatory meeting.** SNWMF must approve any late arrivals in advance. **Please read and sign both sides of this document, include deposit, if required, and mail by: June 1st, 2017**
